| Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into Willow Brook's care.   |  | £250         |
| Personal Care of the deceased before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be resting at Willow Brook Funeral Directors until the funeral unless requested otherwise.  |  | £350         |

| Viewing of the deceased for family and friends at Willow Brook's Chapel of Rest, Kidwelly - By appointment with the funeral director– Shane Griffiths   |  | No Fee       |
| At a date and time you agree with Willow Brook Funeral Directors, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.                       |  | £300         |
| <b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>   |  |              |
| <i>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</i>   |  |              |
| <b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>   |  | <b>£1100</b> |
| <b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)</b>  |  | <b>£1800</b> |
| <b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>  |  |              |
| <i>For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b>.</i>   |  |              |
| In Kidwelly Town Cemetery, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:   |  | <b>£880</b>  |
| <i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the grave digger fee (interment fee); for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>                 |  |              |
| <b>For an Attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b>.</b>   |  |              |
| In Llanelli, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is (from 10am):  |  | <b>£835</b>  |

| <b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>  |  |              |

| Additional mileage (price per mile)   |  | £1.10 a mile |

| <b>The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.</b> |  |              |

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
